

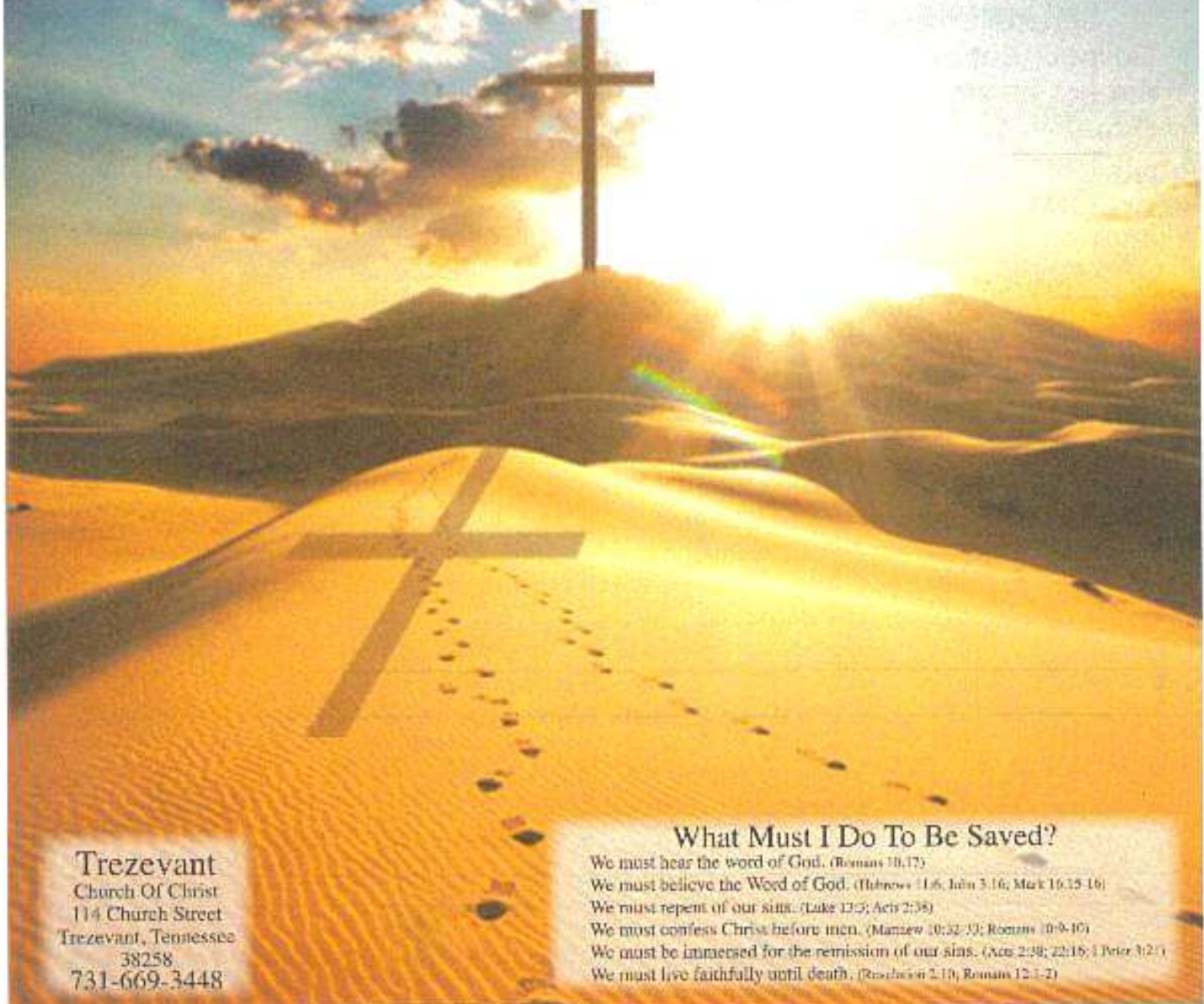

- We must confess Christ before men. (Matthew 10:32-33; Romans 10:9-10)
- We must be immersed for the remission of our sins. (Acts 2:38; 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21)
- We must live faithfully until death. (Revelation 2:10; Romans 12:1-2)



DON'T BE A BIRD ON A WIRE

Have you ever seen a bird sitting on an electric wire? There they sit high above the ground. They watch, chirping at the other birds sitting nearby and whistling at danger below. Their little feet tightly grasp the wire. But they are unaware of the tremendous power flowing through their perch.

Christians can become like those little birds. We cling tenaciously to the Gospel. But are we truly aware of the power that flows there? Paul said, "I am not ashamed of the Gospel ... it is the power of God unto salvation" (Romans 1:16).

The Gospel has the power to change and save. Jews who screamed for the death of Jesus were redeemed by the Gospel. Gentiles who worshiped idols of all kinds were transformed by the Gospel. Paul, the chief of sinners, who persecuted Christians to the death was ransomed by the Gospel. Do we still believe in the power of the Gospel?

Let us not be as those who have a form of godliness but deny the power, ever learning but never coming to a knowledge of the truth (II Timothy 3:5-7). Let us not be as the birds on the wire, perched on our high-minded way, whistling at sin from a safe, uninvolved distance. Rather, let us connect to the Word and boldly proclaim the powerful gospel of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
