FOOTBALL GAMES ARE NOT FOR ME!

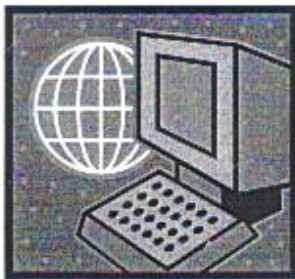


I've made up my mind never to attend another football game. I've been an avid football fan for many years, but now I've had it. Let me list the reasons why:

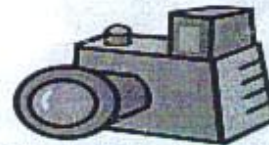
September 18th- Youth Singing at Sitka. 6:00pm.

"TIM'S TIDBITS" -INFLUENCE-

1. We need to be careful in picking the ones to run with in life. The apostle Peter said: "Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you" (I Peter 4:4). Someone once said, "What I need is somebody to make me do what I can." For example: A man with great firmness made a debtor pay the \$25.00 dollars he owed. Later the man who was tempted to be dishonest said to him, "you are the best friend I ever had. You made me become a man."
2. The Bible issues this warning against going with certain kinds of people: "Make no friendship with an angry man, and with a furious man thou shalt not go; lest thou learn his ways, and get a snare to thy soul" (Proverbs 22:24-25).
3. If we hang around with people that is a bad influence, it should be for the purpose of changing them - not to become like them. The Spirit guided Christ to become "a friend of publicans and sinners" (Matthew 11:19).
4. We deceive ourselves if we think we are exempt from outside pressures. "Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manner" (I Corinthians 15:33).
