

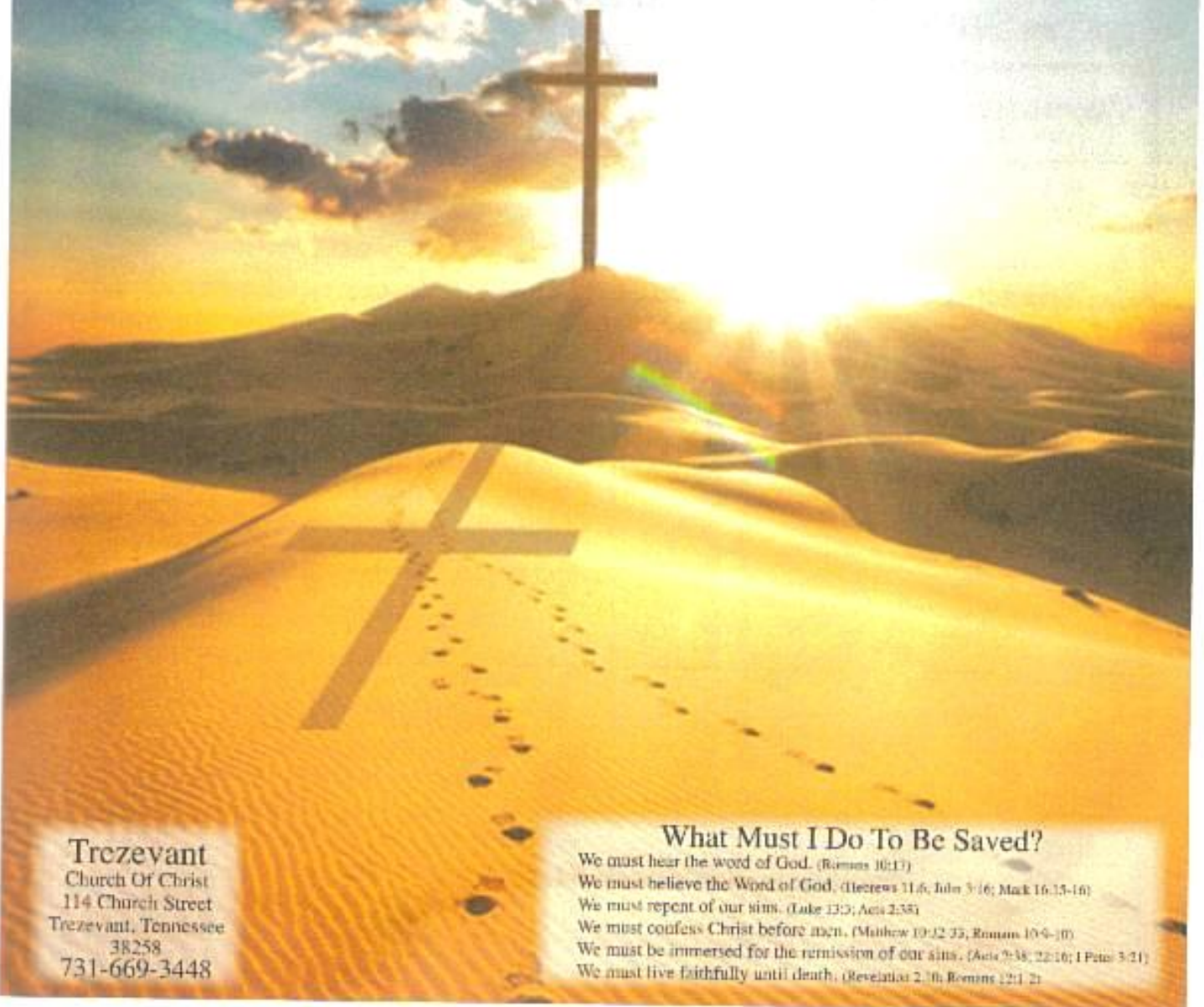

*"The longer I live, the more I realize the impact of attitude on life. Attitude, to me, is more important than facts.
