INTRODUCTION:

Imagine your life for a moment: "When I was just a little bitty fellow, I would tell Mom and Dad that someday I was going to play college and then professional footbalt." (Jay's Journey, Rogers, Jay. 2012, pg. 27). We have probably all dreamed dreams at a very early age. There is a problem, however, when those dreams get crushed before you even have an opportunity to reach them. "Because of my plays a line of the opportunity to play a single down for my high school team. My heart was broken. I ate, drank, and breathed football. All the years I put my heart and soul on the line in practice and during games to reach my goal of playing high school football had all came crashing down." (Rogers, pg. 32). What do we do when that happens? How do we go on? Do we quit? Do we give up? Whose fault is this? What do we do with all this PAIN?

Job: Chosen for Perseverance

- God is aware of those who hold first. James 5:11 "Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience
 of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very PITIFUL, and of lender mercy."
- 2. The book of Job is one of the greatest ever written.
 - n. The book is part of God's Holy Word.
 - b. The book recounts the drama of human life and human emotion.
 - e. Job's struggles, trials, and victories represents the struggles, trials, and victories of all mankind.
- Satur thinks that there is no such thing as unselfish faith, Job 1:7-12
 - n. When someone does a good deed, we wonder-"What he is getting out of it?"
 - b. When one questions the existence of unselfish faith, they are merely following the example set by Salan.

You: Chosen to be Steadfast

- Define the word steadfast. Steadfast (from Webster's Dictionary) "a. firmly fixed in place; not subject to change. b. firm in belief; determination."
- 2. How would your book read?
 - a. Would it rank as one of the greatest ever written?
 - b. The success of your book depends on you. It depends on your faith!
 - What is Faith? Hebrews 11:1; Romans 10:17
 - ii. Faith comes from a person's heart which leads to a great and wonderful belief. Romans 10:10; Romans 1:16
- 3. What would your book say about your Pain? Did the world see God through your pain?
 - a. How do we face challenges? How should we face challenges?
 - Jesus faced it head on with the Word of God. (Sutan Tempting Jesus) Matthew 4:1-11; Luke 4:1-13
 - We all have problems or challenges in our lives. James 1:2-6. So how do we face them?
 - b. Jay's Journey explained: "I'm not sure when or where my journey with cancer will end. But one thing I do know. By the grace of God, and with all the understanding with which He assures us that we can know, MY JOURNEY WITH CHRIST WILL NEVER END! He is my Comfort, my Mediator, my King, my Elder Brother, my Friend, my Savior, and He is my All! Someday, I will live with Him forever." (Rogers, pg. 100).
 - Determination, Steadfastness, Fuith, and Love are ingredients in the recipe for a Christian to follow to let his/herlight shine (Matthew 5:14-16) so that the world can see God through our Pain.

Five Suggestions for facing your challenges head on!

- 1. Understand that life is truly a blessing from God, Philippians 1:21.
- 2. Never take a day for granted. James 4:14
- Never take your mom, dad, family and friends for granted. Say those important words: "I love you. I need you in my life.
 Thank you for all you do, etc."
- Understand that this life is preparing you for your next life and you have to overcome temptations, obstacles, and challenges so you can gain that victory someday. If Timothy 4:6-8.
- 5. This one is hard sometimes, but "See the Bigger Picture".

Final Thoughts:

Job's life lessons help prepare us and teach us:

- 1. We are certain to suffer and be tried.
- We are certain to be separated from earthly possessions (maybe even while we live).
- 3. It is impossible to explain and/or analyze everything in life or about God.
- 4. We learn that to end our journey with the Lord is VERY GOOD!

Search God's Holy Word. Open your heart to the Lord and let him fill it up until it overflows with love. God wants three things from us; obedience, worship, and evangelism. (Fell/show the world how Awesome He is.) When we give God what he wants, we will show the world God through our pain, happiness and life. When we give God what he wants, we will find peace and happiness. When we give God what He wants, we WIN at our challenges.

Someday, all our challenges will be over and our life will end. Our life will give way to VICTORY!
