Garfield refused on the grounds of another appointment. The cabinet member then insisted that the national matter was of such great importance that the President should break his engagement.

Garfield refused. The cabinet member remarked, "I would be interested to know with whom you could have an engagement so important that it cannot be broken." Garfield replied, "I will be as frank as you are. My engagement is with the Lord, to meet Him at His house and at His table at 10:30a.m. tomorrow, and I shall be there." The President was at worship services the next morning. The nation survived the crisis. President Garfield was a member of the Lord's church.

The Lord's statement is still true, "*Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you.*" (Matt. 6:33). DO YOU keep your appointments with the Lord?
