Garfield replied, "I will be as frunk as you are. My engagement is with the Lord, to meet Him at His house and at His table at 10:30a.m. tomorrow, and I shall be there." The President was at worship services the next morning. The nation survived the crisis, President Garfield was a member of the Lord's church.

The Lord's statement is still true, "Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you." (Matt. 6:33). DO YOU keep your appointments with the Lord?
