Some time ago, I learned a couple of things about this prayer/ poem. According to a book I read, the author is Eugene Henry Pullen. I found it interesting to learn who is responsible for the thoughts that have been expressed probably millions of times.

I also found it interesting to learn that there is a second stanza (or a second part of the prayer). It contains these words:

Now I wake and see the light:
'Tis God who kept me through the night.
To Him I lift my voice and pray
That He will keep me through the day.
In Jesus' name, Amen.

I wonder why we do not know the second part as well as the first part. I wonder if it reflects an attitude that basically says, "God, during these upcoming hours when I feel as though I have no control, I'll trust You to care for me. On the other hand, when I am owake and feel in control, I can handle it fine without You. Thanks anyway."

Do we entrust our lives to our Father always or just when we sense that we are facing something beyond our power and/or ability to control? Maybe the thoughts of David, as expressed in Psalm 18-1-3, should be our attitude twenty-four hours a day:

I will love thee, O LORD, my strength. The LORD is my rock, any my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower. I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised; so shall I be saved from mine enemies.
