I can remember when we got a boat when I was younger. We went fishing and fished all day long. Nobody caught a fish the whole day. We thought about leaving, and I started reeling in my pole so we could leave and I started yelling "I GOT ONE!" I was so excited I almost fell out of the boat. After I clamed down dad helped me get the fish in the boat, I was all smiles for the rest of the day. At the end of the day, I was the only one that caught a fish.

Some people may think that was a waist of time, but not my great-granddaddy, Glen "Boat" Utley and me. As soon as we got home we took it down to show "boat" my great granddaddy my first fish I had ever caught. I was so excited about it and so was he. Dad has told me stories about going fishing when he was younger with his granddad and dad. They planned their trips about what snacks they would eat while fishing. He said some days they would catch a lot of fish and eat lots of snacks and then sometimes they wouldn't catch any fish, but they still ate a lot of snacks. Jesus helped the disciples catch many fish, but Jesus is not concerned about fish. However he is concerned about bringing men to God. We read in Matthew 4:18-22 where Jesus called Peter, Andrew, James and John from their boats and said, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."
