- ☒ Which is more important to you? Speaking out on current political issues or speaking out to help someone understand Bible truth?
- ☒ Which is more important to you? The time you spend playing tennis (or fishing, hunting, golfing, etc.) or the time you spend with your children?
- ☒ Which is more important to you? The time you spend adorning your body or the time you spend improving the inner man?
- ☒ Which is more important to you? What you think of last Sunday's sermon or what God thinks of your response to the sermon?
- ☒ Which is more important to you? The preacher speaking to you at the door after worship or the preacher speaking to you through the sermon?
- ☒ Which is more important to you? The condition and appearance of your house or what goes on inside your house?
- ☒ Which is more important to you? The temperature in the church building or the spiritual temperature of the church which meets in the building?
- ☒ Which is more important to you? The number of people who show an interest in you or the number of people in whom you show an interest?

Someone has observed that worry is like a rocking chair - it will give you something to do but it won't get you anywhere. Even though we all know that this is true, we from time to time find ourselves guilty of worrying. However, that is not my intention in writing this article.

My intention is to get all of us to do what the Bible tells us to do when we are tempted to worry; that is, to pray. To the Philippians, Paul wrote, "Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your request be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:6-7).

Great peace of mind is available if we will only pray. We must always remember that when we worry, we take the approach of unbelievers rather than the approach of believers (Matthew 6:32). As believers, we have been given a better way of dealing with problems. We have been given the avenue of prayer (James 5:16).

The next time you are tempted to worry, think about the way that God has given you to deal with this temptation and then cast all your cares upon Him knowing that He care for you (I Peter 5:7).
