We must be immersed for the remission of our sins, (Acts 20x, 22 16; 1 Peer 3/21)

We must live faithfully until death; (Revolution 2:16: Rosson 12:1-2)

Why Don't We Know The Rest Of It? Jim Faughn

The following words are very well known to most of us:

Now I lay me down to sleep; I pray the Lord my soul to keep; If I should die before I wake, I pray the Lord my soul to take. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Some time ago, I learned a couple of things about this prayer/ poem. According to a book I read, the author is Eugene Henry Pullen. I found it interesting to learn who is responsible for the thoughts that have been expressed probably millions of times.

I also found it interesting to learn that there is a second stanza (or a second part of the prayer). It contains these words:

Now I wake and see the light;
'Tis God who kept me through the night.
To Him I lift my voice and pray
That He will keep me through the day.
In Jesus' name, Amen.

I wonder why we do not know the second part as well as the first part. I wonder if it reflects an attitude that basically says, "God, during these upcoming hours when I feel as though I have no control, I'll trust You to care for me. On the other hand, when I am awake and feel in control, I can handle it fine without You. Thanks anyway."

Do we entrust our lives to our Father always or just when we sense that we are facing something beyond our power and/or ability to control? Maybe the thoughts of David, as expressed in Psalm 18:1-3, should be our attitude twenty-four hours a day:

I will love thee, O LORD, my strength. The LORD is my rock, any my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower. I will call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.

10 Differences Between LIVE and DEAD Churches

- 8. LIVE churches are filled with great givers; DEAD churches are filled with folks holding back for "a rainy day."
- 9. LIVE churches have the fresh wind of love blowing; DEAD churches are given to bickering.
- 10. LIVE churches evangelize; DEAD churches fossilize.

If One Were Saved Before Baptism . . .

- ◆ He would be saved before his sins are remitted.

 Acts 2:38 "Then Peter said to them, Repent ye, and each one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."
- He would be saved before his sins are washed away. Acts 22:16 "And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord."
- ◆ He would be saved before he is born again.

 John 3:5 "Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say to thee, Except a
 man be born of water and lof1 the Spirit, he cannot enter into
 the kingdom of God."
- ◆ He would be saved outside of Christ. Galatians 3:27 "For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ."
- ◆ He would be saved before his is saved. I Peter 3:21 "The like figure to which [even] baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:"
- He would be saved sooner than the Lord promised him that he would be saved. Mark 16:16 "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned."
