### Interesting Facts About The Bible

- The Bible was divided into chapters by Cardinal Hugo in 1250.
- The New Testament was divided into verses by Sir Robert Stephens in 1551.
- The whole Bible, divided into chapters and verses, first appeared in 1560 in what is known as the "Geneva Bible." It was so called because it was prepared by the Reformers in Geneva. It is also called the "Breeches Bible," because Genesis 3:7 is translated: "They sewed fig leaves together and made themselves breeches."
- The Bible is the most translated book in the world. It has been translated into more different languages and dialects than any other book that has been written.
- $\bigcirc$  The Bible continues to be the best seller in the world.
- $\square$  The Bible is the best book in the world.
- It is the only book that reveals the origin, mission, and destiny of man.
- $\square$  It is a textbook on salvation.
- There is no conflict between the Bible and the *facts* of science. There may be many conflicts between the Bible and the *theories* of so-called scientists, and between the *facts* of science and the theories of so-called "Bible scholars."
- Above all things, the Bible should be studied and obeyed and taught.

### Let's Slow Down and Rethink This!

Seems like everything changes so fast in our world today. Matter of fact we are moving faster. We have so many things to do and so many places to go, we are going, going and going some more, normally at a very fast pace. Instead of sitting down and eating a meal we can drive through to a window, pay for our food and eat it while driving down the road and loose only a minute or two.

Generally, we are people who are in a hurry to get where we are going. (Normally running late!) Because we are so busy, we sometimes find ourselves leaving some things undone. We generally leave out our family time and our time we should be devoting to God.

Wouldn't it be nice to start a "NEW RELIGION" that would allow us to do things how we wanted, when we wanted, and what we wanted with God and our worship to Him? This would probably fit our lifestyle better, but starting a "new religion" or a "church" is not possible and still be in the right relationship with God. God through His Word (The Bible), has instructed us how He wants us to worship and live. Although the world is changing daily and we are getting more high tech daily, our Lord and Saviour, "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever" (Hebrew 13:8).

Other verses in the Word of God tell us we should not be changing God's way. Notice what Paul told Timothy in II Timothy 3:16-17, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works." Since the Bible teaches the scriptures are complete and the law of the Lord is perfect, Psalms 19:7 "The law of the LORD is perfect, *converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple"* there is no room for change. Christ is unchanging and is the very heart of Christianity.

Also, notice what Paul wrote in I Corinthians 15:1-4 "Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:" The facts of the Gospel of Christ never changes, nor does the facts to be believed -DEATH, BURIAL, RESURRECTION.

Do we need to start a new religion? The answer to this is most definitely, NO! If we will continue to preach, teach and live by God's Holy Word then we will have that hope of Heaven. Galatians 1:8-9 *"But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed." We have the Gospel of Christ. The Gospel of Christ will solve every problem of the world if we will study and apply to our lives.* 

We shouldn't start a new religion, nor should we be looking for one. We shouldn't be looking for change in God's Word. The Word of God is complete, perfect and shall not pass away. Matthew 24:35 *"Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."* Instead of looking for a change or something new *"my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord." I Corinthians 15:58.* 

My prayer is that we can all slow our lives down, show love to our family, friends, neighbors, fellow Christians and our Father in Heaven. Let us slow to the point that we spend needed time in God's Word. II Timothy 2:15 *"Study to show thyself approved to God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of Truth."* If we will truly spend time studying we will know that we must follow God's teaching, His plan for Worship, and His plan of Salvation. We will then learn to be content. Paul knew how to be content. He spent time in prison for living a Christian life and he learned to be content. Philippians 4:11 *"Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatever state I am, [with that] to be content."* With knowledge we will be happy with "Just Living A Christian Life" and not looking for something more convenient.
