No invitations into our home; no invitations to worship with us; no meaningful interactions with them at all. Just smiles and waves and talk of how many miles I planned to run.

We're busy people- all of us. This is a fast-paced society in which we live. We run on well defined tracks. Little time to venture off our tracks and slow our pace to interact with people who are not imperative for our ongoing well being.

But let's remember, we can and must continually extend the healing, ministering hands of Christ because there are people hurting, families shattering, lives tormented, just two doors down.
