President Eliot of Harvard was 88. Asked how he accounted for his good health and vigorous mind he said, "A calm temperament expectant of good."

Winston Churchill said, "Rational, industrious, useful human beings are divided into two classes: First, those whose work is work and whose pleasure is pleasure; and secondly, those whose work and pleasure are one. Fortune's favored children belong to the second class. Their life is natural harmony."

- 6. Don't hold postmortems; brooding over sorrows and mistakes.
- 7. Do what you can for those less fortunate than yourself; especially those who blessed your life.
- 8. Keep busy. A busy person doesn't have time to be unhappy. "I know that there is nothing better for them than to be happy and enjoy themselves as long as they live (Ecclesiastes 3:12).
