Consider the difference between a strong and weak cup of tea. Either cup is composed of the same ingredients. What makes one strong and the other weak? The strength of the tea comes about as a result of the length of time tea leaves are immersed in water. It's called the steeping process. The longer leaves are immersed, allows the water more time to get into the tea and the tea into the water. If more time is invested in the steeping process, the tea becomes stronger. Consider the analogy: the amount of time we spend in the Word of God determines how deeply we get into God's Word and how deeply the Word gets unto us. Just like the tea, the longer we are in the Word, the "stronger" we become.
