HOW TO BE RELIGIOUSLY MISERABLE

Some members of the church never attend regular assemblies of the congregation with any degree of regularity. This has been the practice of some since New Testament times (Hebrews 10:25).

At first such a member realizes that he is doing wrong; his conscience hurts him. His feeling of guilt are amplified and he feels miserable when a fellow Christian says something to him about being missed at church. This feeling grows every time he is near a preacher at some public gathering for fear the preacher might say something about his being absent. Then, when brethren begin calling upon him, his distress is multiplied because he knows why these members are visiting him.

By this time his misery may motivate him to try going to church again-but just on Sunday mornings! "Maybe," he thinks, "this will get rid of the misery." Then when everyone at church tells him they certainly have missed him and how glad they are to see him, he feels guilty. In fact, he may feel somewhat like a stranger. Then if the sermon has some point which makes him feel uncomfortable (as almost any sermon will now), there are more feelings of guilt.

By this time, the cycle is complete. This member feels guilty for not going to church, and he feels miserable when he does! One can hardly get more miserable than this!

THE ANSWER IS OBVIOUS: Attend all the services of the church. Get involved in every good work. Take full advantage of every opportunity to grow and prosper in Christ. Fully, totally, wholly give yourself to the Lord. This cures religious misery immediately and works every time it is applied to the problem.
