## The Heart of David

David is described in various ways, but perhaps the best is this: "...I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfill all my will (Acts 13:22)." But despite this endorsement from God, David was not without issues. Both his godly heart and his human weakness are embodied in the same narrative. King David violated several commandments in his desire for Bathsheba - coveting another man's wife, committing adultery with her, deceit in the cover-up of the affair, and even the murder of her husband, Uriah the Hittite. However, when confronted by Nathan the prophet, David was convicted of his sin and confessed he had sinned against God (2 Sam. 11-12).

Just how sincere was David regarding his iniquities? The Scriptures record his penitent heart in Psalm 51:

- *Have mercy upon me, O God... blot out my transgressions (V. 1).*
- *Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin (V. 2).*
- *For I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me (V. 3).*
- *Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I will be whiter than snow (V. 7).*
- *Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out mine iniquities (V. 9).*
- *Create in me a clean heart; and renew a right spirit within me (V. 10).*
- *Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me (V. 11).*

So from this dark chapter in King David's life, we learn that....

- Even a man after God's own heart can make bad decisions and commit sin;
- When confronted with sin, we, like David, should be willing to make ready confession;
- We should follow David's example - that of a broken spirit and a contrite heart - when we come before the Father asking His forgiveness.

May we be honest with ourselves about any sin in our lives, and may we strive to offer God what He desires when we repent of those sins.
