Three Strikes, You're Out!

This is the time of year when baseball is starting up. Major league teams are in spring training; college teams are beginning to play their scheduled games. While there have been many changes in the game over the years, some things have been constant. One of them is the general rule that a batter gets three strikes to put the ball in play or he is out. What if God dealt with us that way?

David, the man after God's own heart (Acts 13:22), acted on his lust of another man's wife (strike one); attempted to hide her resulting pregnancy by enticing her husband to spend the night with her while he was on leave from his post in the army (strike two); then had her husband killed in battle (strike three). Under baseball rules, David would be out. Both adultery and murder were punishable by death (Lev. 20:10; Ex. 21:12-14). Any form of deception is a lie, and all liars will be in the lake of fire (Rev. 21:8). David was guilty of two acts worthy of an immediate physical death penalty and one which, if not repented of, would result in the ultimate spiritual death penalty. God is longsuffering, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance (2 Pet. 3:9). David did not strike out with God, but was forgiven his sins because of the nature of God and the fact that David was penitent.

However, God's patience and His longsuffering are not without limit for those who continue in sin. Paul wrote that those who knew God but did not glorify Him as God by making idols were given up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts (Rom. 1:21-24) – strike one. Then when they changed the truth of God into a lie, He gave them up to vile affections (Rom. 1:25-26) – strike two. And when they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, He gave them over to a reprobate mind (Rom 1:28ff) to do those things worthy of death – strike three.

A life of sin separates us from God and will result in eternal damnation in hell. There may come a time when He gives us up because we continue to ignore His call. It is our choice and our responsibility to come to God. If we are obedient to Him we should not hear, in effect, at the judgment, "Three strikes, you're out."
