Self-Deception

We can be deceived in many ways. For example, we are inundated by those who would deceive us with what is described by a new term, fake news. We can be deceived because of our own naiveté when we are too trusting. We are deceived by those who lie to us in a believable way. We may be deceived because of things done in secret by those we know and trust. The world is full of those who try to deceive, and there are plenty of us who are gullible enough to be deceived.

While the realization we have been deceived in worldly matters may leave us feeling foolish or angry, we must especially be on guard for those who would deceive us in spiritual matters, for they carry eternal consequences: *Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters ...shall inherit the kingdom of God* (1 Cor. 6:9-10). Many false teachers are trying to draw away disciples after them (Acts 20:29ff). Our eternal salvation depends on our doing that which is right.

The worst situation of all, however, may be when we deceive ourselves. The Bible repeatedly warns of this: (cont'd)

- Be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves (James 1:22).
- If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is vain (James 1:26).
- For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself (Gal. 6:3).
- If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us (1 John 1:7).

We deceive ourselves when we think we are spiritually stronger than we actually are: Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall (1 Cor. 10:12). Thinking too highly of ourselves puts us in a dangerous position.

Let us be wary of those who try to deceive us into doing that which we know to be in error. And let us be especially careful not to be guilty of self-deception.
