The DNA of Jesus

Have you ever heard of deoxyribonucleic acid? This is the scientific name for what is more commonly known as DNA, the hereditary material in living organisms. Each person's DNA is specific to him or her, making it especially useful in determining identities of people involved in crimes. Because of its similarities within family members, it is also helpful in identifying biological relationships such as siblings and parents.

The Bible teaches that Jesus is the begotten son of God. God acknowledged this audibly from heaven when Jesus was baptized (**Matt. 3:17**), and again following the transfiguration (**Matt. 17:5**). Jesus claimed this when He said that His Father is in heaven (**John 20:17**). As Christians, we are also begotten of God (**1 Pet. 1:3**), but not in the same fashion as His only begotten Son. When we obey the gospel, we become children of God through adoption (**Gal. 4:5, Eph. 1:5**).

We can make an interesting application of the letters DNA as related to Jesus, showing He has DNA from God. The Scriptures inform us of the eternal nature of Jesus in **John 1:1-3**:
"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and

the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made." Jesus thus possessed the **Divine Nature** of God. Immediately prior to His ascension into heaven to be with the Father, Jesus affirmed, "...All power is given to me in heaven and in earth" (**Matt. 28:18**). Regarding this fact, the apostle Paul taught, "Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom unto God...For he [God] hath put all things under his [Christ's] feet" (**1 Cor. 15:24ff**). Jesus likewise then possesses all **Authority**. His DNA is His **Divine Nature** and **Authority**.

Though we do not share this particular and unique DNA with Jesus, as adopted children of God we will share in His inheritance (**Rom. 8:17**) if we remain faithful unto the end (**Rev. 2:10**). Let us rejoice that we have the opportunity to live eternally with our heavenly Father and His beloved Son, Jesus!
