## Puzzles

Do you like to work puzzles? There are various types which capture the imagination of many - word puzzles, such as crossword and word search; number puzzles, like Sudoku; and the long-time popular jigsaw puzzles. I enjoy all of these because they challenge the mind and help keep it sharp.

The Bible is somewhat like a puzzle: It requires diligence to put all of God's instructions together so we can truly see the big picture. There is not one passage which by itself presents everything God has given us in order for us to have eternal life. Instead, like a puzzle, we are to find all of the pieces and put them together. For instance, the plan of salvation has to be pieced together from the scriptures in order to better understand what God has instructed us to do.


One particular part of the plan of salvation that has caused much confusion in the religious world is first found in the New Testament in **Acts 2:21**: "...whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved." In his conversion, Paul was instructed by Ananias, "And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord (**Acts 22:16**).". Later, in his letter to the church in Rome, Paul reiterated, "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved" (**Rom. 10:13**).

Now we can have a clearer picture of what calling on the name of the Lord means. Peter connected it to *Repent, and be baptized...* (**Acts 2:38**). Paul made the connection to calling on the name of the Lord with believing with the heart, confessing with the mouth, and obeying the gospel (**Rom. 10:9ff**). And Ananias connected calling on the name of the Lord with baptism (**Acts 22:16**). It is obviously more than simply calling Jesus, "Lord," for Jesus Himself had taught in the Sermon on the Mount, "*Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven*" (**Matt. 7:21**).

Let us spend more time in the study of God's word.
