## What Is Your Treasure?

There have been plenty of people throughout the ages whose goal was to find that famous lost piece of history which they envisioned would make them set for life. How much time, effort, and money have been spent searching for Noah's ark, the Ark of the Covenant, and any other significant lost religious artifact? The search for treasures such as these, or even the actual worldly riches which are available to some, illustrates the desires of men to have fame and fortune regardless of the cost.

The Bible gives us great insight into what should be our real quest in life. Jesus noted how difficult it is for the rich to enter heaven: *Verily I say unto you, that a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven...It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God* (**Matt. 19:23-24**). Paul wrote that *the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith...* (**1 Tim 6:10**). The desire for riches results in covetousness, which is sinful (**Rom. 1:29**), and is also considered idolatry (**Col 3:5**).

Jesus, in the Sermon on the Mount, taught where our focus should be: *Lay not up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves*      (continued next page)

*break through and steal: But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and thieves do not break through nor steal: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also (Matt. 6:19-21).* Our focus should be on heaven, not on earthly treasure.
