## New Year's Resolutions

As each year winds down, many of us begin to consider resolutions for the approaching New Year. Most involve personal habits which affect our health and relationships – lose weight, quit smoking, spend less/save more money, spend more time with family, etc. Consider the following list of resolutions that would benefit every Christian, not only in the upcoming New Year, but for the rest of our lives.

- **Spend more time in Bible study:** *And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures which are able to make thee wise unto salvation. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works (2 Tim. 3:15-17).*
- **Spend more time in prayer:** *Pray without ceasing. In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you (1 Thess. 5:17-18). Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus (Phil. 4:6-7).*

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- **Give more:** *But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity, for God loveth a cheerful giver (2 Cor. 9:6-7). Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come (1 Cor. 16:2).*
- **Do more good works:** *As we have therefore opportunity, do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith (Gal. 6:10). For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them (Eph. 2:10). Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works (Tit. 2:14).*

Keeping these resolutions will help us as we grow in the faith and mature as Christians, and will help to keep us on the strait and narrow path that leads to heaven. Let us resolve to do more each day that we may grow closer to God and to his beloved son, Jesus.
