## Mulligan

Have you ever tried to do something that was adversely affected by bad luck? Or perhaps instead of bad luck, it was the result of a blunder on your part. Naturally, you wanted a second chance to get it right. This "second chance" is often referred to as a mulligan, a term most commonly used in informal golf.

God does not need mulligans because He gets everything right the first time. The Garden of Eden was perfection. The problems there were not God's mistake, but rather poor choices by Adam and Eve (**Gen. 3:1ff**). Likewise, in the days of Noah, God cleansed the earth of sinful man (**Gen. 6-9**). But as time progressed after the flood waters abated, mankind made bad decisions. And while much of mankind may not understand it, God's plan to redeem man from sin is perfect. His son Jesus fully accomplished His will, even submitting to death on the cross (**Phil. 2:5ff**).

Mankind, on the other hand, is continually in need of do-overs. When we are buried in baptism in obedience to the gospel, we are cleansed from our previous sins (**Acts 22:16**).

God is willing to forgive if we are willing to repent and confess our sins (1 John 1:7ff). He does this because He is longsuffering toward us and does not want any to perish (2 Pet. 3:9).
