## God's Word

One of the KidSing cards is the Bible card. It begins with a few quick responses to a key word or question, and concludes with naming the 66 books of the Bible in order. The very first response comes when the young people hear the word **Bible**: "God's word."

Because the word of God is of supreme importance to us as we seek Him, let's consider what we find in it.

- **Power.** God's word is powerful. *By the word of the Lord were the heavens made... (Psalm 33:6).* The universe came into existence when *God said, let there be (Gen. 1)* and it was. His word, the gospel, *is the power of God unto salvation (Rom 1:16).* *For the word of God is quick, and powerful... (Heb. 4:12).* The Bible, God's word, is there for the spiritual benefit of mankind. It contains everything we need pertaining to eternal life.
- **Life.** Jesus, described by John as *the Word (John 1:1)*, brought us the revealed word of God. Peter said, *Lord, to whom shall we go? Thou hast the words of eternal life (John 6:68).* Jesus said *...the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit and they are life (John 6:63).* If we wish to spend eternity with Jesus and the Father, we must abide by their words of life.

- **Judgment.** We will all be held accountable at the judgment by the word of God. Jesus said *...the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day (John 12:48)*. Everyone will be there (**Rom. 14:10**), and we will be judged according to our works (**2 Cor. 5:10**), out of the books which will be opened in that day (**Rev. 20:12ff**). How will our works stack up against the words of Christ?
- **Victory.** Only those who hear and do the words of Jesus will enter the kingdom of heaven (**Matt. 7:21ff**). And only through an obedient faith, based upon the word of God (**Rom. 10:17**), can we overcome the world. This is our victory in Christ (**1 John 5:4**). Jesus, the living Word, has provided us the victory over death when we are submitted to and in Him.

Let us begin this New Year by focusing more upon the word of God that we might benefit from the power, the life, and the victory available to us through it.
