*Peter and the Rooster*

On the night He was to be betrayed, Jesus told the disciples that they would be offended because of Him that very night. They all disagreed, but Peter was the one who argued with Him. *Jesus said unto him... That this night, before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice (Matt. 26:34).* Peter responded, *Though I should die with thee, yet will I not deny thee (Matt. 26:35).* Let's examine how those denials and the subsequent crowing of the rooster affected Peter.

**When the rooster crowed, Peter realized he was not as close to Jesus as he had thought,** despite having been one of three to accompany Him to the mount where He was transfigured (**Mark 9:2**), being the one who had the faith to ask Jesus if he could also walk on the water (**Matt. 14:28ff**), and being one of three who went further into the garden with Him (**Matt. 26:36ff**).


**When the rooster crowed, Peter was given a reminder about pride.** He had argued with Jesus about the prophesied denials. He was vehement in front of the others that even if all of them denied Him, he never would: *though I should die with thee, yet will I not deny thee (Matt. 26:35).* (He would later pen, *For God resisteth the proud... [1 Pet. 5:5].*)

When the rooster crowed, Jesus looked at Peter, and Peter remembered the word of the Lord, and he went out and wept bitterly (Luke 22:61-62). Because of his godly sorrow and repentance, Peter's relationship with the Lord was restored (2 Cor. 7:10), and a few weeks later he powerfully delivered the first gospel sermon (Acts 2:14-40).

As we contemplate the lessons that Peter learned, let us understand that we are as susceptible to these shortcomings as he was, and may we - as Peter did - take the steps necessary to also receive the Lord's forgiveness.
