*The Cure*

Our government spends untold millions of dollars each year on research of currently incurable diseases. For instance, more than seven million was spent last year researching ALS (better known as Lou Gehrig’s disease), which affects only two of every 100,000 people in the US. Yet ALS remains incurable. Cancer plays a role in one of every four deaths in this country. Despite the fact that tens of billions of dollars has been spent on cancer research and treatment in the past forty years, the death rate has dropped only by about 1% since 1990. The point is to demonstrate how much we are willing to spend to extend our lives on this earth. If a medical cure were found for these now incurable diseases, how much money would people be willing to spend to purchase it?

However, medical research is not the only consideration. For instance, about 85% of lung cancer could be eliminated if people would just quit smoking, yet most refuse. Approximately one-third of all cancers are related to weight, yet around 60% of US adults are overweight or obese. It is obvious that we are willing to spend vast sums of money for medical cures, but as a society we are not willing to change our lifestyles in order to greatly reduce the risks of some cancers. Spiritually speaking, there is one condition which, on our own merit, is incurable, but for which there is a cure. Sin, left untreated, is 100% fatal. The Bible tells us that “*all have sinned*” (**Rom. 3:23**), and that “*the wages of sin is death*” (**Rom. 6:23**). The cure for sin is simple: Believe in God (**Heb. 11:6**) and in His Son (**John 8:24**); repent of our sins (**Acts 3:19**); confess that Jesus is Lord (**Matt. 10:32-33**); submit to baptism for the remission of sins (**Acts 22:16**); and live a faithful life of service to God (**Matt. 10:22**). However, similar to our society that refuses to change its habits even though it knows the risks, the world refuses to change the way it lives and turn to God, ignoring the dangers (**Matt. 7:13-14**).

Even if cures were found for now-incurable diseases, we would still eventually die physically (**Heb. 9:27**). The only cure that truly matters is the cure for sin – spiritual death – and it is readily available for all who are willing to submit to God’s authority.
