# The Follower

## The Journey

In the Bible we read of a couple of journeys on which the travelers were led by God. *Now the Lord had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee... (Gen. 12:1).* Abram, later known as Abraham, followed God from Ur of the Chaldees to the land of Canaan. *And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey... (Ex. 3:8).* More than four hundred years later, a specific line of Abraham's descendants were led by God out of Egypt, where they had been enslaved, into the land of Canaan. In each of these examples, God led His people out of the life they knew into a new life. This is a figure of the journey God wants for each of us to take - the journey through life to heaven, the ultimate Promised Land.

Unlike many journeys, everyone has the opportunity to participate in this one. The price is not so expensive that some cannot afford it; the trip is not so difficult that some are not able to endure; and the destination is such that all should really want to go there. *And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming (continued next page)*

down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away (**Rev. 21:1-4**). And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads. And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever (**Rev. 22:1-5**).

Who would not want to go to such a place, especially since the cost of the journey is so affordable? Pay careful attention to the words of one of my favorite songs:

*I am going on a journey to a place where all is new,  
There I'll be in heaven with loved ones who have been so kind and true;  
Now I want to tell you, neighbor, that I hope to meet you there,  
But you must prepare for heaven if its beauties you would share.*

This is the journey God wants to lead us on. He has taken care of the cost through the blood of His son. He asks only that we willingly submit to His will in order to reach the final destination. Let's make this journey.
