## My Faith Shall Be Sight

Recently as we sang the hymn, *It Is Well with My Soul*, I was especially fascinated with a phrase in first line of the last verse. I have sung these words numerous times, and never before had I thought of them in precisely this way. The writer of the song expresses the thought that he is ready for the day when “my faith shall be sight.” In his descriptive words, that day will be for mankind as if the clouds will be rolled back like a scroll, accompanied by the trump of the Lord as He descends toward the earth. That is indeed a glorious picture for those who are in Christ! But what does the phrase *my faith shall be sight* mean?

We read that *...we walk by faith, and not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7)*, and that *...faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen (Heb. 11:1)*. **Romans 8:24-25** teaches that *...we are saved by hope; but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience hope for it*. Our salvation is based upon faith and hope, both of which look forward to things we have not seen, but through the Scriptures we have evidence and assurance that they will be seen. As we walk through life by faith, we anticipate the fulfillment (*cont'd next pg*)

of the promises we cannot see until the end. Thus, my faith shall be sight when God's predetermined day arrives and the Lord Jesus comes for those who are His. Figuratively, the clouds will be rolled back to reveal the sight of the glory of the Father, the Son, and the place - Heaven - which has been prepared for those who are His.

God, who cannot lie (**Tit. 1:2**), has provided great and precious promises (**2 Pet. 1:4**) that are available to all who are willing to submit to His will. His word provides both the basis for our faith and the evidence for our hope that eternal life is a reality. All He expects from us is that we hear, believe, and obey Him. May each of us walk by faith, yearning for the day when our faith shall be sight.
