The Bible uses the word *father* in three ways:

- *Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name (Matt. 6:9)* is a direct reference to God;
- *I am the God of thy fathers (Acts 7:32)* refers to ancestors;
- *Therefore shall a man leave his father and mother (Gen. 2:24)* denotes the man who is our earthly parent.

With today being the annual observance of Father’s Day, we will focus our discussion upon our earthly fathers.

The ideal father is the man who loves God with all he has (**Matt. 22:37**), loves his wife as Christ loved the church and gave Himself for it (**Eph. 5:25**), and brings up his children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord (**Eph. 6:4**). He provides his family with a proper example of godliness in the life he leads. He is a loving, faithful spouse to the mother of his children. He administers the necessary discipline and provides instruction to help his children to grow up to be faithful Christians who will, in turn, be good parents.
