Disney has been around much longer than I have. From the loveable characters of Mickey Mouse and Donald Duck, to the captivating movies of *Bambi*, *Dumbo*, and *Cinderella*, to the Disneyland and Disneyworld theme parks, the creations by Walt Disney were warmly received by parents and young children alike.

But an old saying from a work of Shakespeare comes to mind: "All that glitters is not gold." In my adult lifetime, Disney has become the epitome of that adage. - *And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually (Gen. 6:5);*

- *And the Lord said, Because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous, I will go down now... (Gen. 18:20ff);*
- *...Who changed the truth of God into a lie... God gave them up unto vile affections... women did change the natural use into that which is against nature... the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one for another... that which is unseemly (Rom. 1:25ff).*

And now Disney, at the forefront promoting unnatural affections of men and women, is blatantly rubbing it in our faces.

While many in the world favor this affront to God and His holiness, God cannot be pleased. Just as in the days of Noah and Sodom and Gomorrah, there will be a price to pay, for those who are unrighteous *shall not inherit the kingdom of God (1 Cor. 6:9-10).*

But there is a cure for those who are willing: *And such were some of you. But you were washed...sanctified... justified in the name of the Lord Jesus (1 Cor. 6:11-12).* For God, who hates the sin, loves the sinner and wants him to be made whole.

May we, in all ways and at all times, be interested in that which is righteous before God, and put away that which is unseemly.
