*Of That Day and Hour*

Have you ever had an unexpected change of plans? We plan ahead as if everything will be in normal routine when “that day” arrives. Many of us even procrastinate preparing because the event is still in the future and we think we have plenty of time. However, as we all know so well, our lives are not always in normal routine. Though we should always expect the unexpected, we almost never do. So when the unexpected occurs and plans change, we miss out on the “planned for” occasion.

Jesus clearly taught this principle regarding the approaching Day of Judgment. In response to a question asked by His disciples about when this would take place, He replied, “*But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no not the angels of heaven, but my Father only*” (Matt. 24:36). Jesus used the building of the ark to illustrate how the people went about their everyday lives until the day when Noah and his family went into the ark and the floods came and took them all away. He later used the parable of the virgins, for which the planned event was a wedding, to illustrate the need to be prepared. There were ten who went out to meet the bridegroom as he arrived for the wedding banquet. Five of these virgins were totally prepared, but the other five were not. Had the bridegroom arrived at the expected time, (cont'd next pg)

all ten would have been ready. But when he was later than anticipated, the five unprepared had gone for more oil. The door was locked and they were left outside, missing his coming and the banquet (**Matt. 25:1-13**).

Likewise, some give no thought to the coming Day of Judgment. Others think about it, especially when it is mentioned in worship services, but believe they have plenty of time to prepare. Thus they procrastinate doing what they know they need to do. Both God and His Son Jesus have proclaimed that there is a day coming *in the which he will judge the world by that man whom he hath ordained* (**Acts 17:31**). Those who are unprepared will be cast into outer darkness from the presence of the Lord for all eternity. Are you ready?
