*Their Iniquity Is Not Yet Full*

Among God’s promises to Abraham was the land promise, and several times this promise was repeated (**Gen. 12:7; 13:14-15; 15:7**). God told Abraham that He had brought him out of Ur to possess this land and that it was promised to his descendants. One provision of the promise was that the land would not be given to Abraham’s seed until the iniquity of the Amorites was full (**Gen. 15:16**), and more than four hundred years would pass before that promise would be fulfilled (**Gal. 3:17**). Neither Abraham, nor his son Isaac, nor his grandson Jacob, nor his great-grandsons would see the fulfillment of this promise. The promise would be fulfilled when God was ready. No one but God would know when the sins of the Amorites were such that He considered them ready for punishment.

The Canaanites are not the only nations that God has judged because of their iniquities. He judged mankind in the days of Noah because their hearts were only evil continually, and He destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah because their sin was very grievous. God used Israel to punish the Canaanites, and then the Assyrians and the Babylonians to punish the Israelites.

The question we might ask, then, is what about the United States? When will our iniquity be full? Our nation surely fits the descriptions we find in the Bible regarding sinful people: *Woe unto them that call evil good and good evil... (Isa. 5:20); ...The priest said not, where is the Lord? and they that handle the law knew me not; the pastors also transgressed against me, and the prophets prophesied by Baal, and walketh after things which do not profit (Jer. 2:8); ...Save yourselves from this untoward generation (Acts 2:40); ...that ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation (Phil. 2:15).*

No one can know when or if God will bring punishment upon the United States, but both the Bible and secular history demonstrate that when nations become decadent and immoral to the point that anything goes and nothing is sacred, the time will come for the fall. *Righteousness exalteth a nation; but sin is a reproach to any people (Prov. 14:34).* All we can do is diligently seek God and strive to be lights in this perverse and wicked nation.
