## What Will Your Answer Be?

*Someday you'll stand at the bar on high, Someday your record you'll see; Someday you'll answer the question of life. What will your answer be? What will it be? What will it be? Where will you spend your eternity? What will it be? O, what will it be? What will your answer be?* This first verse of an old, familiar hymn raises very relevant and interesting questions about our lives on this earth.


There will come a time when we will have to give an answer. The books will be opened at the judgment: *...and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works...every man according to their works (Rev. 20:12-13)*. What will be revealed about your life on earth? Did you hunger and thirst after righteousness? Did you strive to be humble and meek and pure in heart? Did you seek worldly treasure or heavenly treasure? Did you love others as God loved you? Were you willing to forgive? When asked how you treated your fellow man, what will your answer be?

What about your belief in and service to God? Have you obeyed the gospel? Paul wrote concerning Israel, *But they have not all obeyed the gospel (Rom. 10:16)*, despite having had it preached to them. He also wrote, *For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God (1 Cor. 1:18)*. Obedience to God is emphasized (continued next page)

throughout the Bible, and especially with regard to the gospel of His son, Jesus Christ: *Seeing you have purified your souls in obeying the truth unto unfeigned love of the brethren, love one another with a pure heart fervently, being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of the incorruptible word of God which liveth and abideth forever (1 Pet. 1:22).* Jesus said those who do not believe on Him are *condemned already (John 3:16-19)*. If you've not been obedient, what will your answer be?

And how have you treated God's word? God has warned against adding to, taking from, or perverting His word: *Every word of God is pure: he is a shield unto them that put their trust in him. Add thou not to his words, lest he reprove thee and thou be found a liar (Prov. 30:5-6)*. *I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ into another gospel: Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ. But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed (Gal. 1:6-8)*. When asked how you treated God's word, what will your answer be?

God is not willing that any should perish; He rather wants all to know the truth and be saved. But alas, not all will. When you stand before God, will you be prepared? What will your answer be? ~Freeman
