*Why Call Ye Me Lord?*

Obviously, not everyone in the world believes that Jesus of Nazareth is the Lord. Some do not believe because they have never heard (**Rom. 10:9-17**). Others do not believe because they are not convinced that the Bible is the word of God. But those who do believe Jesus is Lord do so because the Bible tells us He is. Peter’s sermon on the first Pentecost after Jesus’ resurrection began with a quotation from the prophet Joel, “*And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved*” (**Acts 2:21**), and was followed by the declaration that “*God hath made this same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ*” (**Acts 2:36**).

But simply because many acknowledge that Jesus is Lord does not mean that they act accordingly. Jesus asked, “*And why call ye me Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?*” (**Luke 6:46**). Why would He ask that question? Because He knew that many would refer to Him as Lord, but would not really mean it. They would not demonstrate that belief by their actions in life. They would not be submissive and obedient to Him despite calling Him Lord. Jesus addressed this attitude when He said, “*Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven*” (**Matt. 7:21**).

Sadly, on the Day of Judgment, most will hear the damning words, "I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity" (**Matt. 7:23**). Some of these will have outright denied Jesus as Lord. Some will have verbally acknowledged His lordship, but will not have truly believed it and acted upon it. Still others will be among those who did truly believe in Jesus, but who allowed the pleasures of this world to take precedence in their lives.

If you believe Jesus is Lord, why would you not want to do what He says? The Hebrew writer affirms that *Jesus is the author of eternal salvation unto all who obey Him* (**Heb. 5:9**). Do you believe that? Are you doing what He says?
