*Imagine This*

Now the Lord had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country...unto a land that I will shew thee (**Gen. 12:1**); ...not knowing whither he went (**Heb. 11:8**). Do you ever wonder what Abram thought? "What will this land be like? How will I get along with the people?" I know how it would be for me: My imagination would be running wild, wondering what would lie ahead!

We have been called to go to a place we have never been or seen, and we can only use our imagination. While we get some glimpses from the scriptures, we cannot truly fathom it. We have been invited to a place being prepared by Jesus in His Father's house for God's children (**John 14:1ff**). Heaven is described by John as a bride adorned for her husband, a place where there will be no more sorrow, pain, sickness, or death (**Rev. 21:1ff**). We will see the river of water of life and the tree of life, and there will be no night there (**Rev. 22:1ff**).

However, regardless of how descriptive the Bible is regarding heaven, God has let it be known that we cannot truly imagine what it will be like: *But, as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither hath entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him* (**1 Cor. 2:9**). Paul also wrote, "For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not

worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us" (Rom. 8:18).

Just as is the case in reading books about people and places we have never seen, the Bible provides passages such as these which stir our imaginations about what comes after death. But remember this, regardless of what we envision, it will be so much better than we could ever dream. Let us strive to be ready to take advantage of the invitation to go to heaven and experience that which we can only imagine.
