*Now You See Me*


An entertaining movie debuted in 2013 titled *Now You See Me*. The primary point of the movie was that things are not always as they appear, that what you see may not be what you get. Making a spiritual application of this idea, we, as seekers of God and His will, may not always see things as they are.

For instance, the Almighty God is described in various ways throughout the Scriptures, but we do not have any idea what He looks like. We can name several of His attributes: He is loving (**Rom. 5:8**); gracious (**Titus 2:11-12**); merciful (**Titus 3:5**); longsuffering (**2 Pet. 3:9**); and forgiving (**1 John 1:9**). But whenever He appeared to men, He was masked in some way. They could know He was there, but they could not actually see Him as He is. He appeared to Abraham in the form of a man (**Gen. 18:1ff**). He appeared to Israel on Mount Sinai as a cloud accompanied with thunder and lightning (**Ex. 19:15ff**). When Moses was with Him on the mount, Moses was allowed to see Him only from behind, in the cleft of a rock, with God's hand over His eyes (**Ex. 33:17ff**).

There is coming a time when we will see both the Father and the Son as they are. At the judgment seat of Christ (2 Cor. 5:10), when we receive that which we are due for eternity, everything will be revealed. For children of God, John made this very clear: *Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is (1 John 3:2).* But those who are not His will receive the punishment they deserve and will see Him in His wrath. Therefore, we should continue on the path to heaven so that when that day comes, it will be as if the Lord is saying to us, "Now you see Me."
