## *If It Is Not How You Die...*

In a recent episode of a TV show we watch, one of the characters was rapidly approaching death. When his young daughter, who had been protected from knowing how dire the circumstances were, got the chance to talk with him, he told her she could ask whatever she wanted and he would tell her the truth. She asked if he was going to die, and he replied, "Yes." And then he told her that she would die, too. She responded that everyone dies, which was exactly what he wanted her to understand. His next words to her were quite profound: "It is not how you die that matters, it is how you live your life." He wanted her to understand that living a life of helping others is more important than how one dies.

As Christians, we are exhorted to be helpers:

- *As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are the household of faith (Gal. 6:10).*
- *See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men (1 Thess. 5:15).*

- Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem the other better than themselves. Look not every man on his own thing, but every man also on the things of others (**Phil. 2:3-4**).

If we are focused on serving others, we will be the servants that God would have us to be.

Everyone is going to die (**Heb. 9:27**). We are all going to stand before the judgment seat of Christ (**2 Cor. 5:10**), where we will receive according to how we lived our lives. Remember, it is not how we die that is important. It is that we live our lives serving God and our fellow man that will matter at the judgment.
