
## Harvest Time

In another instance, He told His disciples, “*Say not ye, there are yet four months, and then cometh the harvest? Behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields, for they are white already to harvest*” (**John 4:35**).

Those involved in fields, crops, and harvests, knew when the harvest time was and were prepared to work. Jesus wants us to know that the spiritual harvesting is a year-round event. We do not have to wait for the right time of the year to begin reaping the crops. Harvest time in the fields of souls begins now and stops when the workers have completed their lives on earth. Let us take Jesus' examples to heart and get busy in the fields.
