## Jesus Is Alive!

It has been said that attitude is everything. Consider some of the lyrics of the song *Blue Skies and Rainbows*:

*Blue skies and rainbows and sunbeams from heaven  
Are what I can see when my Lord is living in me.  
I know that Jesus is well and alive today;  
He makes His home in my heart.  
Nevermore will I be all alone since He  
Promised me that we never will part.*

This song is not saying that Christians will always have lives filled with blue skies, rainbows, and sunbeams; that would be unrealistic. Christians suffer difficulties in life because we live in the world. We get incurable diseases that require physically demanding treatments. We encounter temptations that we sometimes allow to lead us away from the strait and narrow path leading to life. We are subject to trying circumstances – financial problems, the unexpected death of a loved one, debilitating injuries, etc. – and such can weigh on our minds so that we might feel there is no hope. The lyrics to this song, however, illustrate the attitude we can and should have because of our faith in Jesus. We see (continued next page)

the beauty of everything around us, and we should know that the One who made it all is there for us when times are rough.

When Paul wrote to the church at Corinth concerning the gospel of Jesus, He reminded them of the witnessing of the resurrected Christ (**1 Cor. 15:1ff**). We, too, have every reason to have hope because He is alive. Our attitude should be that regardless of what curves life throws at us, we have hope through the One who lives in us.
