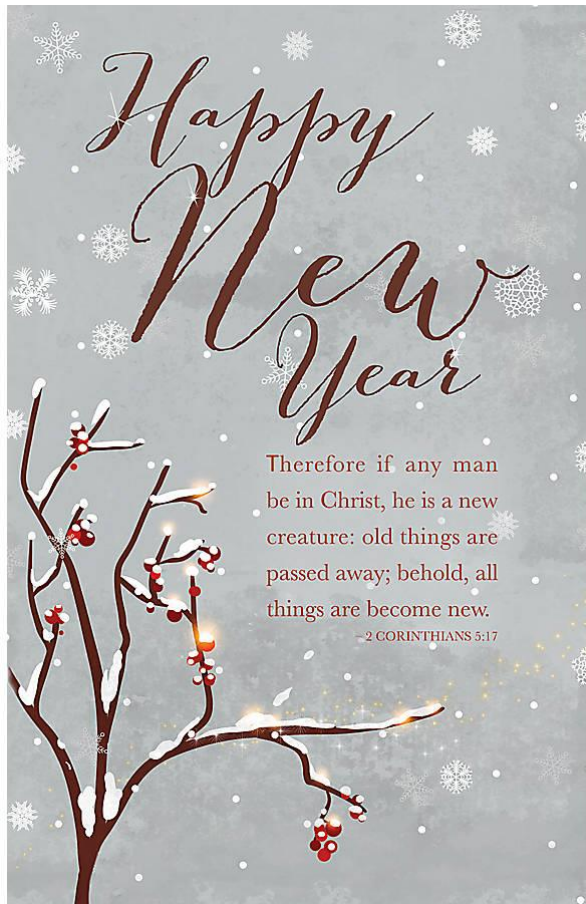
We can talk to one more. When was the last time you invited someone to our services? When was the last time you had
