What comes to your mind when you hear or use the word "almost?" Almost means nearly, or not quite completely, and it's a word we use every day:

- We are almost home, which actually means we are not home.
- I am almost sixteen means I am still just fifteen.
- We are almost finished with our project indicates we still have something left to do to be completed.
- We almost won the game is the way losers describe a moral victory. "Almost won" really means that regardless of how close the score, we lost the game.


There are some Bible passages in which the word "almost" is used, or at least implied. We could say that King Saul almost carried out the instructions of the Lord regarding the utter destruction of the Amalekites. He slew all the people except the king and took only the very best of the spoil to offer sacrifice to God. Thus we could observe that Saul almost obeyed God, but instead, Samuel told him that he had disobeyed (**1 Sam. 15**). When Governor Felix heard the words from Paul regarding *righteousness, temperance, and judgment to*

come, he told Paul he would wait for a more convenient time (Acts 24:22ff). And King Agrippa, responding to Paul's description of his encounter with Jesus on the road to Damascus, declared, "Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian" (Acts 26:14ff).

*Almost Persuaded*, a hymn we sometimes sing to encourage the lost to respond, is based on that scripture. Note the ending words, "almost, but lost." How incredibly and eternally sad when someone knows what to do to be saved, but is never completely committed! May each of us be **fully persuaded** so that we will escape wrath of God for eternity!

*Almost persuaded, harvest is past!  
Almost persuaded, doom comes at last!  
"Almost" cannot avail; "almost" is but to fail;  
Sad, sad, that bitter wail: "Almost - but lost!"*
