## Heaven - Inclusive or Exclusive?

"Inclusive" has been a hot-button word for the past several years. Certain segments of our population, which have been excluded due to their life choices, are now being championed to be accepted by all even though those choices are clearly condemned by the Bible. This movement tells us that God is loving, gracious, merciful, and forgiving, and that as Christians we should be the same. To exclude anyone for pretty much any reason is hateful, not loving and kind. What does the Bible have to say on this matter? Will heaven be inclusive or exclusive?


In one sense, God is inclusive. *For God sent not His son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved (John 3:17).* The Bible also says that God is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance (2 Pet. 3:9), and that God will have all men to be saved; and to come to the knowledge of the truth (1 Tim. 2:3-4). Thus, God's wish is that all mankind be saved because He takes no pleasure that the wicked should die (Ezek. 18:23).

But in reality, God has made entrance into heaven exclusive. Jesus said, "Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord,

Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven" (Matt. 7:21). Paul wrote, "Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God?" (1 Cor. 6:9). All who refuse to submit to and obey God will be excluded, not included, in the kingdom of heaven unless they repent.

Heaven will be an exclusive, not inclusive, realm. Though all are invited, not all will agree to the terms which God has stipulated: being born again and living a faithful life. Thus most will be excluded. Will you be included or excluded? The choice is yours.
