## More than Sacrifice

The words *offering*, *sacrifice*, and *worship* are connected. Abraham was asked to offer his promised son, Isaac, as a burnt offering. Abraham told his servants who accompanied him and Isaac to the prescribed mountain that they were going to worship (**Gen 22:1-5**). When Samuel confronted King Saul with these words, "Hath the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in obeying the voice of the Lord...," Saul responded that he had sinned and asked Samuel for prayer and pardon that he might worship the Lord (**1 Sam. 15:22-25**). Samuel's words still ring true today. God is more interested in obedience than He is the act of worship.

Jesus was questioned by the scribes and Pharisees about His disciples who were transgressing the traditions of the fathers by not washing their hands before eating. But He turned the tables on them when He responded that they were guilty of transgressing the word of God by their traditions. He further told them that their worship was vain because they honored God with their lips but their hearts were far from Him, and that they taught for doctrines the commandments of men (**Matt. 15:1-9**). Simply going through the motions of offering worship to God through words and actions is not enough for God to be pleased. Jesus said

we must worship Him in spirit and in truth (John 4:24) – right actions accompanied with the right heart and attitude.

The wise man Solomon had written centuries earlier, “To do justice and judgment is more acceptable unto the Lord than sacrifice” (Prov. 21:3). God wants man to approach Him in His way, in obedience and with the right heart. May we always strive to worship in the manner that is pleasing to Him.
