Humility

I grew up in a family in which declarations such as, "I am smarter than you," could often be heard. "Smarter" could be replaced with "faster" or "better" or "tougher" or any other word indicating superiority, demonstrating the same attitude. Sound familiar? Why do we need to feel that we are better than others in some way? If we have too much pride, isn't that suggestive of having too little humility? Let's examine what the Bible has to say about that.


The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom; and before honour is humility (**Prov. 15:33**). Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud (**Prov. 16:19**). And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted (**Matt. 23:12**). But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace to the humble (**Jas. 4:6**). Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time (**1 Pet. 5:6**). If we do not demonstrate humility in our lives, God will not be lifting us up.

It is possible that Paul may have struggled with pride issues: And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan, to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above *measure* (**2 Cor. 12:7**). We can easily see how this great apostle – a Jew, a Pharisee, a Roman citizen, and personally selected by the Lord for the preaching of the gospel (which he received by direct revelation) – could have been affected.

Jesus, the only begotten son of God, serves as our perfect example in dealing with this problem. While in the upper room with His disciples, the Master became as a servant and washed the feet of the twelve, a clear demonstration of humility (**John 13:1ff**). Paul spoke of this humble spirit as he encouraged the Philippian brethren to be more Christ-like: *Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem the other better than themselves...Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: who thought it not robbery to be equal with God: but made himself of no reputation,...he humbled himself...even to death on the cross* (**Phil. 2:3ff**).

May we follow the examples set before us and practice humility toward God and man so that He may exalt us at the proper time.
