
## Render Unto Caesar

Whatever the cause, there are scriptural reasons for paying our taxes. Jesus said, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's... (Mark 12:17). Paul instructed, Let every soul be subject to the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. Whosoever resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God (Rom. 13:1ff). Likewise, Peter charged ...submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake... (1 Pet. 2:13ff). Since the federal government is our higher power on earth, and that governing body has an established set of laws for us to live by, we are bound as Christians to live lawful lives. This includes the paying of our taxes.
