## With Whom Do We Stand?

As we go through life, we will cross paths with various people, each of whom will exert some sort of influence on us. These associations may be good for us, or they may lead us down the wrong path in life. Our God, who loves us, has provided some insight concerning the potential dangers of making the wrong choice of friends:

- *Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law doth he meditate both day and night (Psalm 1:1-2).*
- *Do not be deceived: evil company corrupts good habits (1 Cor. 15:33).*

These passages make some very important points for us to consider as we choose our circle of friends. If we think that it does not really matter about those with whom we associate, we are deceiving ourselves. While it may not seem so at first, the longer we are around those who are not interested in godliness, the more likely we will be influenced to become like them. There is a progression suggested in **Psalm 1**: Walking with

ungodly sinners readily leads to standing and then sitting with them. The fact is we are much more likely to be negatively influenced by the ungodly than we are to positively influence them to become interested in God and His righteousness.

Ultimately, if we make the right choice with whom to stand, we will be blessed. Those who are interested in God and His laws will be blessed eternally. Those who are not will be punished eternally. Let us be careful with whom we stand.
