They reassure us that everything will be okay when we think our problems are beyond repair. They are there for our school functions and our ball practices and games. The Bible speaks of several very special moms. Jochebed, the mother of Moses, protected her son from the Pharaoh's Israelite infanticide by putting him in the river in a basket, where he was retrieved providentially by Pharaoh's own daughter. Jochebed was then given the opportunity to nurse Moses and teach him of his true heritage (Ex. 2). Hannah, who was barren until God answered her prayers with the birth of a son, Samuel, kept her promise and gave him back to the Lord when he was weaned (1 Sam. 1). Elisabeth, the mother of John the Baptist, had been barren, but was blessed of God with a son who would serve the Lord (Luke 1). And Mary, mother of Jesus, was a virgin and a godly woman who conceived by the Holy Ghost to bring forth the son of God (Matt. 1:18-25). We esteem these mothers because of their godliness as women and mothers.

If you are so fortunate as to still have a mother on this earth, be sure to take every opportunity to show her that you love her – not just today, but every day.
