Faithful Friends

Friendship is something to be cherished in life. President Woodrow Wilson put it this way, "Friendship is the only cement that will ever hold this world together." While I would suggest that loving Christ and putting Him first in our lives would hold the world together, I believe we all see his point.


As one reads through Paul's second letter to Timothy, friendship is seen throughout. Let's examine the "friends" Paul describes:

- Timothy, "my beloved child" (1:2);
- Phygelus and Hermogenes, who "turned away from me" (1:15);
- Onesiphorus: "he often refreshed me and was not ashamed of my chains" (1:16);
- Demas, "who is in love with this present world, has deserted me" (4:10);
- Luke "alone is with me" (4:11);
- Mark: "he is very useful to me for ministry" (4:11).

Within this list are friends who have been very helpful to Paul in ministry, who stuck with Paul no matter what, and one he would even call his child (in the faith). But the ones who really stand out are those who were not faithful. Demas, described as one who was in love with the present world, deserted Paul. We do not know the exact situation, but he evidently "hung Paul out to dry" because of his love of a sinful, dying world (1 John 2:15-17). Phygelus and Hermogenes were specifically listed after Paul made a statement about a group of people who turned away from him in Asia.

These friends were unfaithful and proved to be of no value. As we have been considering friends, let's focus on a faithful friend who will never leave our side. 2 Timothy 2:11-13 declares, "If we have died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him...if we are faithless, he remains faithful." Jesus is a friend who will remain faithful to the end. He will never desert us or leave us out to dry. The question for us is, will we be faithful to Him?
