By the Recipe

There are some really good cooks who do not use a recipe but just put some stuff together and it turns out great. However, many of us who cook need a recipe, even if we might modify it a little to make it suit our taste. At our home, sometimes one of us will decide to cook something we both like, but cannot find the recipe. That means trusting our rusty memories and then hoping we come up with something which at least remotely resembles the appearance and taste of the dish we had in mind. Whether we follow recipes in cooking or not, if the final product is good, what difference does it make?

But what about getting to heaven? Does God have a recipe for salvation? Yes, He does and He has given it to us. We must believe in Him and diligently seek Him (**Heb. 11:6**). We must also believe that Jesus is the Christ, His son who died to wash away our sins (**Jn. 8:24; I Jn. 4:10**). God has commanded all men everywhere to repent of their sins (**Acts 17:30-31**). Without making a public confession of Jesus, we will be denied by Him (**Matt. 10:32-33**). And we must be buried

with Him in baptism to also be in the likeness of His resurrection, having our sins washed away (**Rom 6:3-5; Acts 22:16**). After having been born again through this obedience to the gospel (1 **Pet. 1:22-23**), we must then demonstrate our faithfulness to God by walking in the light (**1 John 1:7ff**), by worshiping Him in spirit and in truth (**John 4:24**), and living a life that is a good example for others to follow (**Matt. 5:16**). Other ingredients to be added include kindness, tenderheartedness, and forgiveness (**Eph. 4:32**).

Unlike recipes on earth that may be modified or even ignored with no consequences, God's recipe is not to be tampered with. We cannot make changes to suit our personal tastes else we face dire consequences (**Gal. 1:6ff; Rev. 22:16ff**). Let us always strive to follow God's recipe "to the letter" for the salvation of our souls.
