As one man said, "Know your limits, but never accept them."

Especially when we're talking about spiritual goals, we're often extremely short-sighted. Have we forgotten Who we have helping us? At times like these, it's important to remember the

powerful words of Ephesians 3:20-21, "Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen."

Just because we place boundaries on ourselves doesn't mean God is somehow limited by them. He can do tremendous things through us! So, let's think bigger. What can God do through us? Only He knows the answer. As far as we are concerned, let's be praying big and then preparing for great things!
